- · Create a 5-foot noncombustible buffer around your home and deck.
- · Check and maintain your roof and gutters.
- Install ember-resistant vents.
- Ensure a 6-inch vertical clearance on exterior walls.
- · Clear and maintain decks, porches, yards and structures from 5 to 30 feet.
